- **Text Messaging:** All categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third parties.
- **Legal Requirements:** We may disclose your information if required by law or to protect the rights, property, or safety of South Psychology, our patients, or others.

Data Security

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information. Your information is stored in secure networks and is only accessible by a limited number of authorized personnel who have special access rights to such systems.
